CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Must be a resident of North Carolina.
- 2. Grade point average must be 3.0 or better.
- 3. Must major in some area of Criminal Justice or related field.
- 4. Must supply copy of the Federal Student Aid Report. The student need criteria number will be considered.
- 5. Scholarship check will be made payable to the institution in which the recipient will be attending.
- 6. The number of siblings in the family will be considered and if any are currently attending college.
- 7. Student must be active in the community, church and/or school activities.
- 8. The student must have no felony convictions or convictions of serious misdemeanors. The student must also have no pending criminal matters.
- 9. The student must not have exceeded 24 years of age by the application deadline.
- 10. The most recent official high school and or college transcripts must accompany each application, complete with 4 references and SAT scores.
- 11. One scholarship of \$1000 dollars will be awarded to the top applicant and two (2) scholarships of \$500 dollars each will be awarded to the top two additional applicants.
